1. News

ARTS is organizing a Design hackathon! DASH from the 3rd to 5th of November. We will do our best to get freshmen involved. The architects had a two-week orientation. The faculty and guild have presented the upcoming fall semester. The number of courses available in ELEC for the summer have been increased.

Some small problems with the ELEC grants on the first round, regarding the grant application links. The Computer Science Guild has been on board in starting the Engineering Science program. Challenges with the SCI project course: The course is mandatory but there are more participants than fit in the course. The issue is being considered by the faculty member in charge of the bachelor program. There is also a second, different course with the same kind of problem. Oodi allows 200 signups, but the lecture room fits only 150 students. Students have faced threats of removal from the course. The professor responsible has been notified. As a field of expertise, information networks sits between industrial management and information technology, and when courses have been discontinued on the industrial management side, it has not been informed beforehand to information technology. Info tech does not have their own professor, but the guild is gathering funds on its own (need is 500k), and we've now reached a 20% benchmark on the funding drive.

CHEM Vuorimieskilta has been busy with their upcoming 70-year anniversary. The guild has advertised its' activities to freshmen.

AYY is taking part in the University's strategy projects, one of which includes the AllWell! Questionnaire. Based on the findings, a fifth of students at the university feels exhausted. The well-being strategy project has been well resourced. In orientation the new students were introduced to the Student Union, its activities and the opportunities that students have in influencing in the University. Advocacy communications have been developed. AYY has participated in a pedagogical forum (an event in developing the teaching of universities).
